



RSCDS Photography Policy – Individuals under 18s

For parents and legal guardians

The Royal Scottish Country Dance Society (RSCDS) would like to use photographs and/or video recordings of your young dancer taken by the Society or by persons or organisations authorised on behalf of the Society for the purposes of internally and externally promoting the Society. These images could be used in any media (existing or later created) including print and digital media formats such as print publications, prospectuses, brochures, websites, e-marketing, posters, banners, advertising, film, social media, teaching and research purposes.

Images on websites can be viewed throughout the world and not just in the United Kingdom, some overseas countries may not provide the same level of protection to the rights of individuals as UK legislation provides.

The Society may keep these images or recordings permanently once they are published and be kept as an archive of Society life.

The Society will not identify your young dancer by name and will not pass on the images or recordings to be used by any other organisation except to illustrate features promoting Scottish country dancing and the Society.

This document refers only to photographs/videos taken by our photographers and/or used in our official publications, social media or press releases. Other attendees at social events (e.g. evening dances) or in public spaces, may take and post photos online or on social media.

The Society is committed to processing information in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR). The personal data collected on this form will be held securely and will only be used for administrative purposes.

Your rights

You have the right to request to see a copy of the information we hold about your young dancer and to request corrections or deletions of the information that is no longer required. You can ask the Society to stop using your images at any time, in which case it will not be used in future publications but may continue to appear in publications already in circulation.

You have the right to lodge a complaint against the Society regarding data protection issues with the Information Commissioner's Office (<https://ico.org.uk/concerns/>).
